

BIRD LIST – OWEN SOWERWINE NATURAL AREA – 2022 Update

This cumulative list of 168 species is based on visits and surveys during all seasons by members of Flathead Audubon Society and others from 1991 to the present, including Kalispell Christmas Bird Counts (begun in 1999). The area is also a hotspot in Cornell's eBird program, and many recent updates have come from birders using the eBird app. This list includes species seen along the Stillwater River from Conrad Dr to Leisure Lane and overhead, including species seen adjacent to, but not within the boundaries of the OSNA. Those species known or suspected to breed in the area, based on observations of nests, dependent young, territorial males, nest-building or food-carrying, are marked in **bold**.
